Our penultimate News Bulletin for 2023! The last 2 weeks have been very busy, and we definitely know that Christmas is near. The children have been singing their hearts out to some new songs ... not always the right words or tunes but they are definitely trying. The staff have managed to not do any Christmassy arts and crafts as yet but as of next week - its fair game - after all it is December.



The children visited the hall and played with the parachute again. They are getting very good at listening and following directional instructions. They were all offered turns to sit on top of the parachute whilst the other children tried to shake them off the centre - this activity definitely show cased some of your children's sense of humour. They then had the opportunity to sit under the parachute while the others shook it over them, causing some very funny static induced hairstyles.

Making volcanoes with various ingredients seem to have been very popular this last fortnight. There have been 2 methods in making these and if you would like to do more at home please feel free to ask for the ingredients or use the website for ideas. The children were asked a lot of "I wonder what will happen if....?" questions to get them thinking scientifically.









Painting as ever has been taking place on a daily basis. The Under 2s made some lovely patterns on the paper with their welly boots, after treading in a tray of paint. They were asked to identify specific colours as they made their marks.

Imaginative play has been going on in the form of children initially drawing maps and then recreating them in the playground. They have also been really interested in building houses and castles this fortnight. Because of their interests in the castles and a number of dressing outfits were provided for the children to dress up.

















On Wednesday our snack, which consisted of Cheese savoury shapes, turned into a mathematical exercise. The children were each given a plate of biscuits and asked to count various shapes. Lissie showed them how to make a tally

chart.



In the back garden the leaves have been a popular resource. The children have enjoyed sitting on piles of leaves and throwing them in the air. We have talked about their texture and the sounds they make when trodden on.



Artificial snow was introduced in the setting and the children appeared to enjoy making a snow village. The Under 2s played with the shaving foam and pretended it was snow. They have also been playing with frozen sand and ice in the playground.



This Friday, after many requests, an obstacle course was set up in the hall to challenge the children and their self confidence. Each child listened to the safety instructions before attempting the course.


